Photograph story: Suitable for 1 child or more.

Equipment:

- A couple of photographs.
- Paper.
- Pens.

What to do:

Ask the children to hunt for a photo from around the house. It can be a frame on the wall, or one selected from a photo album.

Spend a bit of time discussing the photo. If there are any people in the photo they don't recognise, see if they can guess who they might be, where the photo is taken and what might be happening.

Ask your child to draw a copy of the photo on a piece of paper. Ask them to label who they think the people are, where the photo is taken and what is happening in the photo.

Get them to make this up- it doesn't matter if it's not true!

Ask your child to write a short story about what the people in the picture did before or after the photo was taken.

In addition to drawing a picture of the photo and writing a short story, as the children to bring the photo to life. Act out what happened before the photo, during the photo and after.

Step 1- Create a freeze frame.

Step 2- Bring the freeze frame to life using mime.

Step 3- Add in sounds.

Step 4- Add in words and perform!
