Overview: A simple quiz that might just produce a few surprises!

Time: 5-10 minutes

Equipment required: white board or paper (both optional).

Benefits:

- Very simple game that can be played anywhere, with no equipment.
- Lets children engage with the value of money
- A fun way to play with math skills.

Step One:

- 1. Optional: write "If I saved a penny every day..." on the board.
- 2. Ask the question "If I saved a penny every day, how long would it take to save for..."
- 3. Name an item that you know the current price of. This works best when it's an item children actually want.
- 4. The children can now guess how many days it will take, with you guiding them towards the right answer.

Step Two:

- 1. Ask the class: what different coins could you save each day to speed up getting your item?
- 2. Repeat with a different item how much more/less time would it take to save for this new item?
- 3. Invite children to say whether they think one item is more worth the time than the other.
